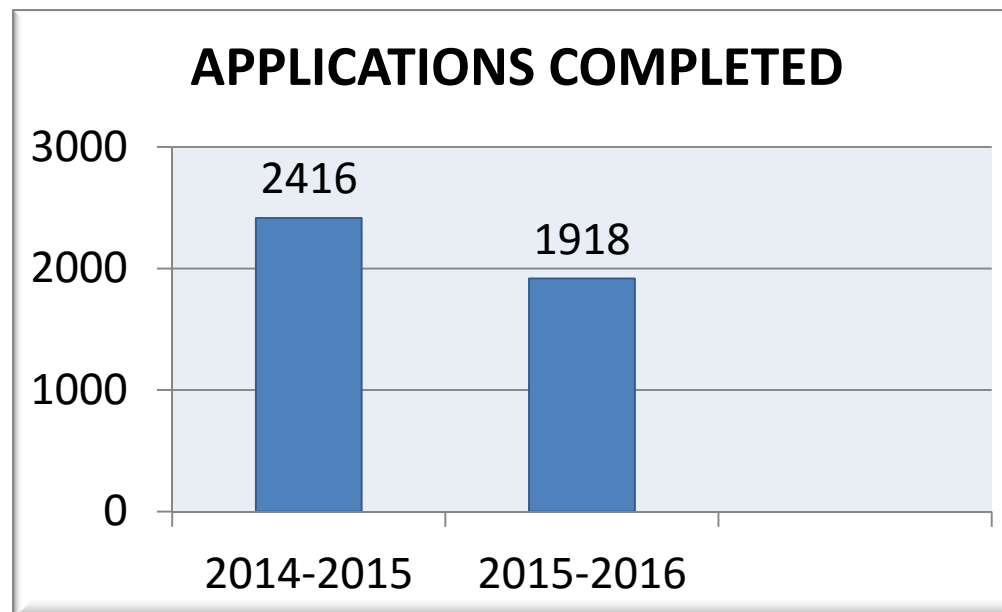

# Energy Assistance Program

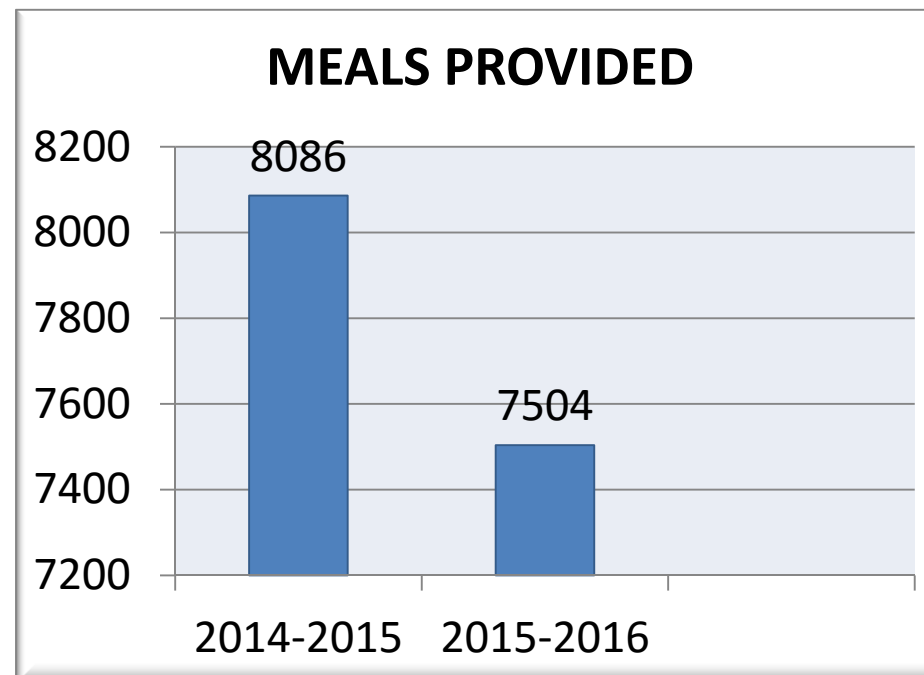
The Energy Assistance Program is a program that provides a one time credit for low-income households. It generally begins in October/November and runs through May. If a household is eligible, a designated amount will be credited to the utility bill.

# Senior Site Meals

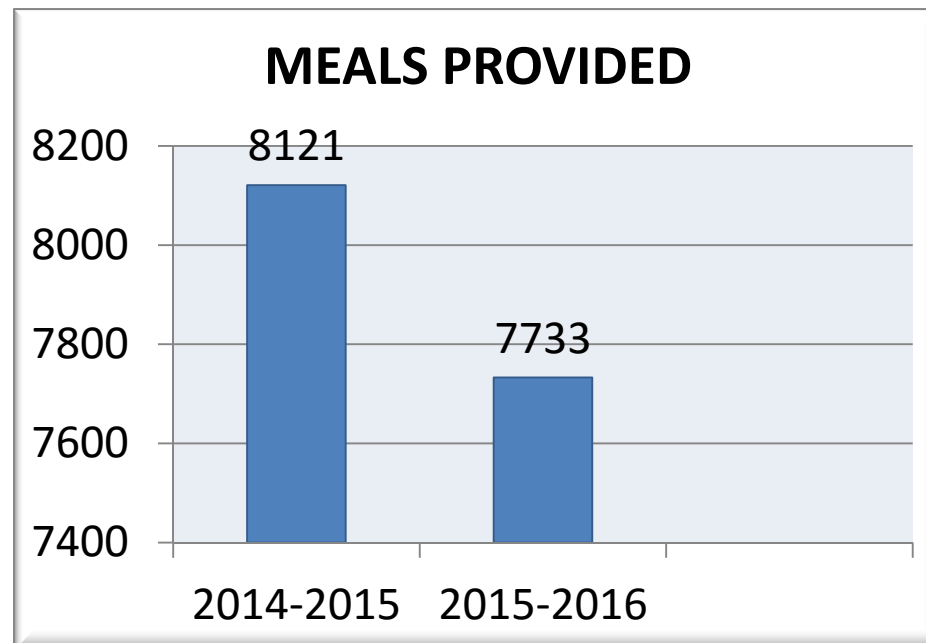
Congregate meals is for person 60 years of age or older at four locations. The meal which provides 1/3 of the daily nutrition, is part of a three hour program each day. The program give seniors a chance to socialize with other members of their community.

# RESTAURANT VOUCHER PROGRAM

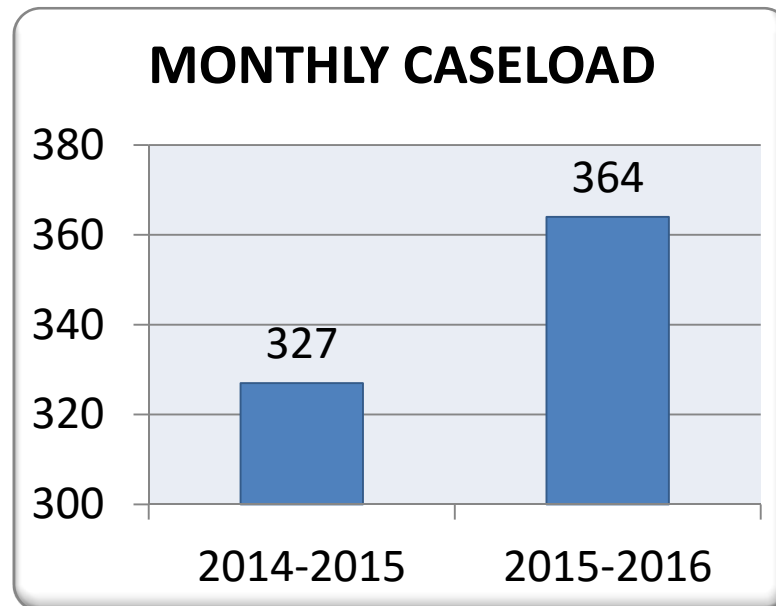
The Senior Restaurant Voucher Program offers seniors, 60 years of age or older, the opportunity to enjoy a hot, nutritious lunch daily at restaurants in Whiting, Highland & Hobart Indiana. In addition to providing 1/3 of their daily nutrition, the Voucher Program gives seniors a chance to socialize with other members of their community. The financial savings also make this a highly desirable program for those in need of economic assistance.

# SECTION 8 VOUCHER PROGRAM

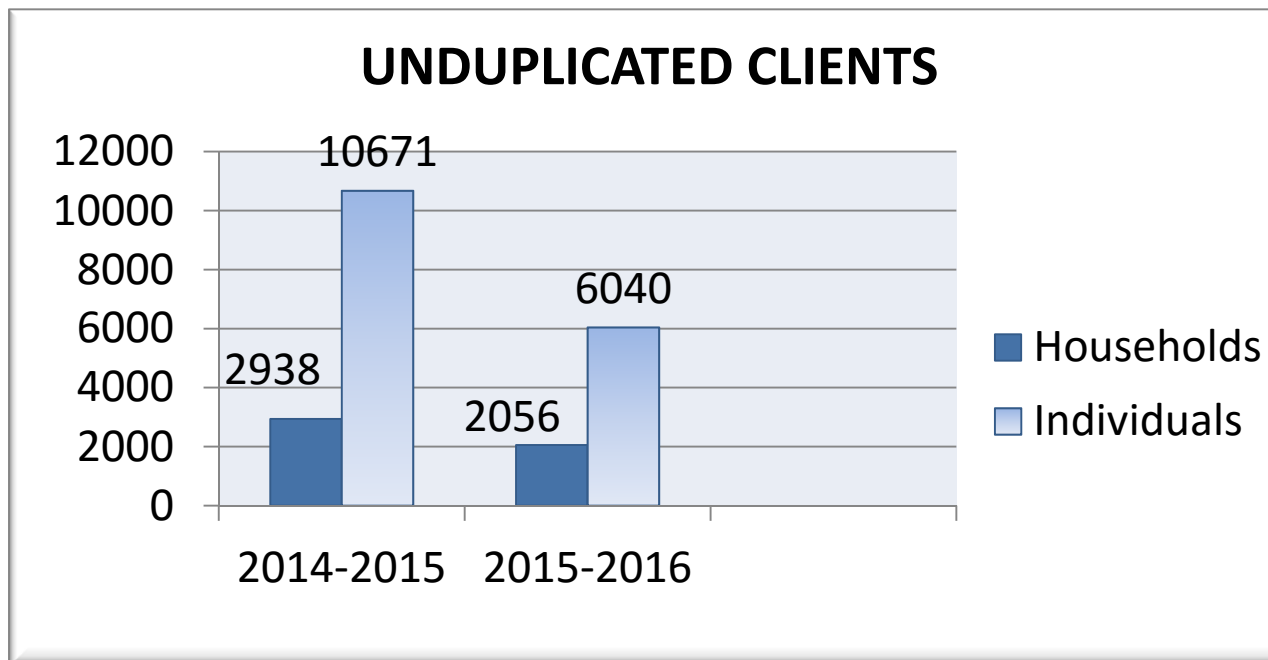
Section 8 Voucher Program is a rental assistance program that assists low-income households with their housing cost. Greater Hammond provides on-going case management for those households that have been identified for the program by the State of Indiana.

# FOOD PANTRY PROGRAM

The Food Pantry provides a three to five day supply of emergency food to families in need every 30 days, or as needed in emergencies.
